- 6. Board of Director's reports

- 6.5 Treasurer (Lisa) Has met with Scotia Bank and has access to the PMHA bank accounts and is monitoring the treasurers' email.
- 6.6 Registrar (Maria) Has prepared the e-store for registration, currently awaiting fees for 2023-2024 and Hockey Manitoba completing their updates.
- 6.7 Fundraising (Tori) Deficiencies have been places on the accounts for individual's who did not complete their fundraising commitments. There is one case where jerseys haven't been returned, Kyle and Tori are working on it. Leo Lapointe has requested a letter from PMHA committing to Operation Red Nose for the 2023-2024 season.
